

## Quick Quiz V

1. R1 and one out, B7 has a 3-1 count. Pitch is in the dirt and calls a ball, ricochets off F2's shinguard and heads toward the dugout. The ball comes to a complete stop outside of the 1<sup>st</sup> base dugout as F2 chases after it. F2 stumbles and kicks the ball into the dugout. The plate umpire calls time when the ball enters the dugout. B7 touches 1<sup>st</sup> just before the catcher kicked the ball.
  - a. R2 is awarded third base
  - b. R2 scores
  - c. B7 is awarded 1<sup>st</sup>
  - d. B7 is awarded 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - e. B7 is awarded 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - f. The plate umpire must rule if F2's actions were intentional
  
2. R1, R3 and 2 outs. Batter hits an inside-the-park home run. R1 misses 3<sup>rd</sup> base. R1's infraction is properly appealed by the defense. How many runs score?
  - a. 3
  - b. 2
  - c. 1
  - d. None
  
3. R2, R2 one out, the offense wants to double steal, but R2 misses the sign from his coach and does not steal. The batter hits a routine pop up between F6 and F4. R1 does not stop, reaches 2<sup>nd</sup> base and is standing on the base with R2. The batted ball hits R2 in the helmet while he is standing on 2<sup>nd</sup> base.
  - a. Infield fly should be called
  - b. R1 cannot be called out because he is protected when standing on the base
  - c. R1 is out
  - d. The ball is live
  - e. Time should be called as soon as ball hits R1
  - f. R1 is returned to 1<sup>st</sup> base
  
4. 2-2 count and one out, the pitch hits B-9 on the hand as he attempts to swing. The ball rolls 3 feet in front of the plate. B9 begins to run to 1<sup>st</sup> as F2 picks up the ball and throws it to 1<sup>st</sup>. B9 is 60 feet up the line and both of his feet are in fair territory. F2's throw hits B9 in the back.
  - a. Live ball until the ball hits B9
  - b. Interference by B9. Time is called and B9 is out
  - c. Hit by pitch. B9 is awarded 1<sup>st</sup>
  - d. Foul Ball
  - e. B9 is out
